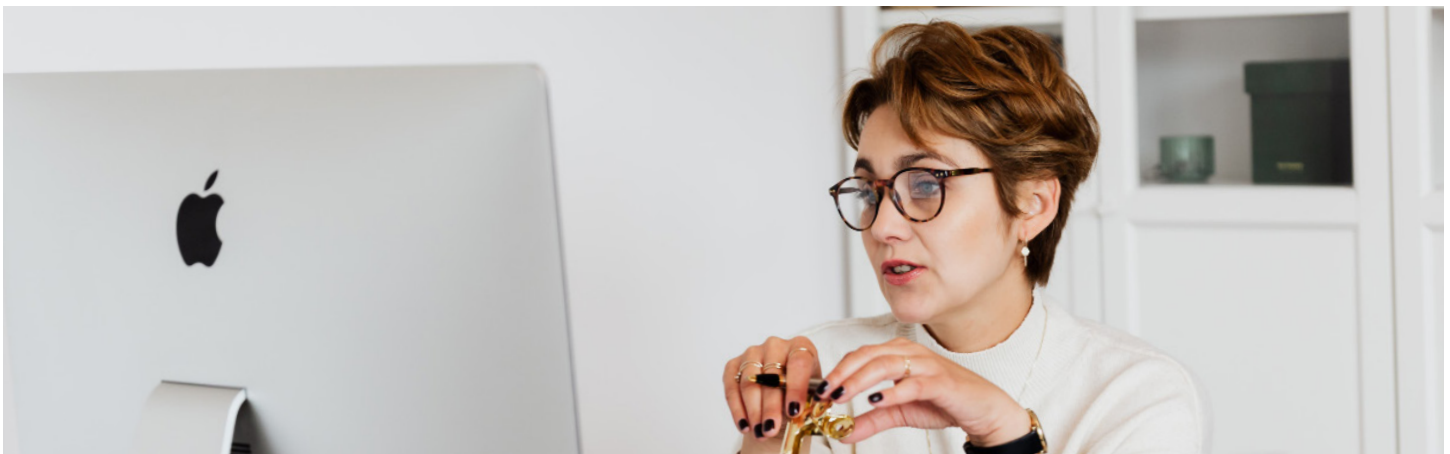


2021 World Family Therapy Congress
